What do you think when you hear the word, "Commitment"?

How have you experienced the truth that we grow "by" commitment not "toward" commitment?

Read Romans 1:20-23. To worship means "to ascribe worth". Take a moment and think about your life what do you ascribe worth to?

Read Romans 12:1-2. Worship is what we do all the time, not just Sunday. How can you become a living sacrifice?

How do you think "ascribing worship" every Sunday in a service helps you "ascribe worth" to God the rest of the week? How does neglecting the priority of Sunday worship create an obstacle to daily worship?

Read 2 Samuel 6:1-15. What's your first reaction when you see God strike Uzzah dead? How can God do this and still be a loving God?

What do you think was going through David's mind during the three months after this? What can we learn about worship that honors God from David's example here?

Read Psalms 24:1-6. How would your worship change/improve if your Sunday morning experience was 100% about God's authority and 0% about you, your needs, your preferences and expectations?

Read Psalms 24:3-4. What makes it difficult for you to be fully prepared for worship? What could you do that would most prepare you for worship every week?

What's the most important "take away" you can apply from this discussion to help you take a next step with God?
